<APPLICATION_TYPE>	"2-char" will be "PM" for Physical Market.
<MARKET_TYPE>	"10-char " will be "OPER_RESV".
<PARTICIPANT_ID>	12-char" will be the name of participant.
<USER_ID>	Currently not used – field will be null.
<DELIVERY_DATE>	"8-char" will be the dispatch date in the format of "YYYYMMDD".
<BID_TYPE>	"10-char" will be "GENERATOR", "DISPLOAD", "INJECTION" or "OFFTAKE".
<RESOURCE_ID>	"32-char" will be name of the Resource.
<TIEPOINT_ID>	"32-char" If <BID_TYPE> is 'OFFTAKE' or 'INJECTION' then <TIEPOINT_ID> will be present.
<HOUR>	"2-char" will be in range of 1-24. For example HOUR 2, means hour ending 2.
<RESERVE_CLASS>	"13-char" will be "SPIN10_MIN", "NONSPIN10_MIN", "30_MIN".
<DISPATCH_TYPE>	"15-char" will be "PRE-DISPATCH".
<CONSTRAINT_TYPE>	"15-char" will be "CONSTRAINED".
<CLR_QTY>	"6-char" number format XXXX.X MW. This is the cleared quantity.
