Energy managers mean business

The big picture

Hiring a qualified energy manager is a sound business decision. They have the technical expertise to recommend energy-saving equipment and technology that are right for your business.

And they have the project management skills required to implement your business' energy management strategy – working directly with your operations team and/or external vendors to get things done in a way that will benefit your company's bottom-line.

A strategic resource

Energy managers who participate in the IESO's Embedded Energy Manager Program are trained to look for ways to improve their organization's competitive position through proactive energy management.

Their job consists of:

- Performing energy audits and feasibility studies
- Coordinating energy retrofits and measuring energy savings
- Monitoring equipment and plant performance
- Leading energy conservation awareness programs
- Identifying energy-saving technology and incentive programs to help save energy

Get results quickly

When you hire an energy manager through the IESO's Embedded Energy Manager Program (or the saveONenergy Energy Manager Program offered through your local electricity distribution company), you get the benefit of having a full-time resource on-site who is dedicated to energy management.

- Their employment contract is a minimum of two years, renewable up to a maximum of five years.
- The minimum annual savings target is 2,000 megawatt-hours.
- Your business receives an up-front payment of \$50,000, with available incentives up to \$200,000 based on documented performance.
- The total incentive is equal to total savings multiplied by \$40/megawatt-hour to a maximum of \$200,000.
