Re: Amp feedback on the CFF Mid Term review

Page 14 of the LTEP states the following:

Beginning July 1, 2018, combined heat and power projects that use supplied fossil fuels to generate electricity will no longer be eligible to apply for incentives under the Conservation First Framework or the Industrial Accelerator Program. Behind-the-meter waste energy recovery projects will continue to be eligible, as will renewable energy projects, including those paired with energy storage systems.

There are no details pertaining to this in the IESO LTEP Implementation Directive or in the Materials IESO shared at the public engagement re: the draft Implementation Plan.

1. Could the IESO please clarify how renewable energy projects, including those paired with Energy Storage will be implemented into the Conservation First Framework and Industrial Accelerator Programs?
2. Could the IESO please indicate the eligibility requirements for renewable energy projects, including those paired with energy storage for participation in the CFF or IAP programs?
3. Could the IESO please indicate how the CFF & IAP incentives will be structured to include renewable energy projects, including those paired with energy storage?
4. Could the IESO kindly confirm that the details and clarifications requested above and that the revised CFF and IAP programs and related program documents will be posted no later than May 15, 2018?
5. Could the IESO also confirm that the CFF and IAP programs will begin accepting applications for renewable energy projects, including those paired with energy storage no later than July 1, 2018?
6. Could the IESO also kindly confirm that Solar PV will be included as an eligible technology as a renewable energy project, eligible to apply for incentives under the Conservation First Framework and the Industrial Accelerator Programs?
