Hi,

Here are some questions we have that pertain to the P4P (EPP) program, after the November 1 presentation:

1. What happens if the participant does not hit the 5% target after 3 years? Are they removed from the program? What if the average savings over the 3 years is greater than 5%? Would that impact the decision?
2. Can a substitution be made in an aggregated set of buildings? For example, lets suppose an aggregation was made for 5 schools, and one onf them was slated for closure after 2 years?
3. Do the costs of the implemented measures need to be disclosed to the IESO and/or the LDCs?
4. For clarification, suppose a building uses back-up generation to minimize co-incident peaks. How does the annual summary report adjust for this?
5. What is the schedule of the various periods (Baseline Period, Implementation Period, Performance Period).
6. Can equipment (e.g. equipment with long lead times) be purchased in anticipation of enrollment in the program?
