**Subject:** Multi-Site Customer Energy Manager Program

Following valuable customer feedback through the Provincial Energy Manager Program Development Stakeholder Engagement from 2015, the IESO is ready to launch the Multi-Site Customer (MSC) Energy Manager Initiative (formerly Multi-Distributor Customer). The MSC Energy Manager initiative is one of a suite of Energy Manager initiatives designed to provide resources to support Ontario companies become more strategic about their electricity consumption.

The Multi-Site Customer Energy Manager Program was designed to be consistent with the LDC Energy Manager Initiative; a pay-for-performance model providing \$40 / MWh with a 2,000 MWh annual target for 2 years. It was developed specifically for large organizations (15MW peak or 75GWh annual consumption) with facilities spanning 5 or more LDC service areas. Existing Embedded Energy Managers in place at large retail organizations over the past 2 years have proven to be very successful. It is anticipated that this program will enable additional organizations to increase their participation in conservation across the province.

There is funding for ten MSC Energy Managers. It is anticipated that there will be great interest in this program. As such, contracts will be offered on a “first come, first served” basis to the first ten eligible Applicants. A waiting list will be maintained in the event that additional funding is available. Applications will be accepted as of 12pm on Friday, January 22, 2016 and can be sent to [conservationcontracts@ieso.ca](mailto:conservationcontracts@ieso.ca).
