December 8 Session Questions and Answers

1. What impact will there be if any on the retrieval of HOEP Pricing?

None of the existing reports available on the IESO Reports site will be affected by the proposed settlement meter data distribution changes.

2. How will monthly DP statistics reports be obtained once the changes are made?

Along with other MV-Web reports, the Statistics Report will no longer be available to download.

Data will be automatically published on the IESO Reports site, similar to the current presentation of documents such as settlement statements in the IESO Confidential Reports site. Market participants will then use their own solutions to present the data.

3. Will settlements service providers need to be provided with certain access so that they can continue the day to day settlement functions?

Yes, the MV-Web "Associations" role will be replaced with a new Meter Data Associate (MDA) relationship at a particular Delivery Point.

Existing active MV-WEB Associations for registered organizations will be automatically migrated as MDA relationships when the new Meter Data Management system goes live.

In the future, these relationships will be granted through Online IESO by the host organization.

4. Have the IESO data revisions always been +1, +8, +18? Or was this changed to +3, +8 +22 business days?

Settlement calendar timelines are not changing as part of the Meter Data Management project.

5. Will the proposed monthly LDC AQEW AQEI reports be Transmitter Reconciliation Preliminary Data Files?

No, the LDC AQEW AQEI reports will not be a Transmitter Reconciliation Preliminary Data Files (TRDF). Unlike TRDFs, which are provided only to transmitters as an aid to verify transmission tariff credits, the LDC AQEW AQEI reports are intended to provide distributors with delivery point meter data for use in their monthly embedded generation data submissions.

6. Are the Validated Meter Data Reports the same as the VEE Meter Files?

The Validated Meter Data Report will contain meter data that has gone through the VEE process in IESO's MDM system.

7. The presentation from December 8 (slide 33) indicates that meter data reports will be published two days earlier than they are currently made available. The 2015 Physical SSPC indicates no change to the timing of file delivery. That is, preliminary statements and invoices would be published on TD + 10 BD, and final statements would be published on TD + 20 BD. Please clarify: will file delivery timing and/or filing deadlines change in Q2 of 2015?

No, the file delivery timing and/or filing deadlines regarding settlement statements and invoices will not change when the new MDM system is in place.
