The final Burlington to Nanticoke Scoping Assessment Outcome Report is now <u>posted</u> following a two-week comment period.

The report details the need for a coordinated regional planning approach and development of an electricity plan – Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) – for each of the Hamilton, Brant and Caledonia-Norfolk sub-regions.
