Regional electricity planning is underway for the [Burlington to Nanticoke](#) region to ensure a reliable supply of electricity, and to support local growth and economic development. Regional planning looks at the unique needs of each region, and considers options and innovative resources to meet the needs of the area.

The Burlington to Nanticoke region generally encompasses the area from Haldimand County and Norfolk County going north towards the City of Burlington. In this area, three Integrated Regional Resource Plans will be developed for the following electrical sub-regions: Hamilton, Brant and Caledonia-Norfolk.

On Monday, September 11 at 1:30 p.m., the IESO will host a [webinar](#) to provide an overview of the regional electricity planning process, and seek your feedback on the draft electricity demand forecast and our proposed engagement plans over the coming months.
