Re: MR-00437: Demand Response – Registration and Metering Requirements

Attached for Technical Panel review and consideration are the following documents:

At the February 6, 2019 Technical Panel meeting, the Panel determined that Resolute’s amendment submission warranted consideration with a high priority. The Panel requested that the amendment submission be discussed at the Demand Response Working Group (DRWG) meeting on February 12th, and that Resolute be invited to present to the DRWG at that meeting. In addition, the Panel invited market participants and other interested persons to make written submissions for a period of two weeks, ending February 21, 2019.

The [February 5, 2019 cover memo](#) indicated the following next steps for the March 5th Technical Panel meeting:

1. Technical Panel review of any written submissions received during the 2-week comment period – no written comments were received;
2. IESO staff to provide a summary of the February 12th DRWG discussions – please see attached IESO presentation;
3. Resolute to make submissions and present to the Technical Panel – please see attached Resolute presentation;
4. IESO staff to articulate its position – since the February 12th DRWG and IESO review of Resolute’s presentation in further detail, the IESO position on Resolute’s proposal is indicated in the attached IESO presentation.

Next Steps

Following Technical Panel review and discussion of the attached presentations at the March 5th meeting, the IESO requests that the Technical Panel continue to support the need for further analysis to understand broader impacts and any related unintended consequences. The IESO proposes that the Technical Panel determine that this be done by way of continued discussions by the DRWG. In keeping with the timeline for the December 2019 Demand Response auction, the IESO proposes that the matter come back before the Technical Panel by the June 29, 2019 Technical Panel meeting to inform a Technical Panel vote on the amendment no later than the August 13, 2019 Technical Panel meeting.
