**Subject:** DRWG - Call for Feedback - Peaksaver Transition MWs

DRWG Members,

As many of you will recall from recent meetings of the DRWG, the expiry of Peaksaver this January 2018 requires the IESO to consider the potential capacity that may be available to compete for a position in this December's DR Auction for a position in the 2018 Summer and Winter commitment periods. The IESO is required to review the impact of potential MWs that could transition into the DRA and is reflected in the Target Capacity.

The Target Capacity is a value that is part of the Pre-Auction Report that is posted to the DR Auction page every year by the end of September (see last year's report [here](#)). For the IESO to prepare for the potential Peaksaver transition, feedback from stakeholders who may be in a position to represent such load are being asked for that specific feedback (i.e. an estimated amount they expect to transition in year 1). This information will help inform the IESO's review and setting of the Target Capacity for the upcoming auction.

Specifically, Local Distribution Companies or other residential aggregators who may have first-hand experience or insight into the potential amount of MWs that could transition to the auction as the Peaksaver program expires in January 2018 are being requested to consider submitting feedback with respect to this information.
