**RE: DR Auction: Path to Success in the DRA**

Enel X, a leading provider of flexibility services worldwide, thanks the IESO for the opportunity to present recommendations on removing barriers and improving efficiency of the demand response resource at the April 25<sup>th</sup> DRWG meeting.
