The IESO would like to meet with the Market Renewal Working Group prior to the stakeholder session on February 24 in the Toronto airport area. The Working Group will meet from 9-12, followed by a broader stakeholder session that will take place in the afternoon from 1-4.

The working group meeting will contain two components. First, the IESO would like to discuss the proposed stakeholder engagement framework and structure. Second, the IESO wants to have a discussion on the goals, objectives and principles for the market renewal project going forward. These were first [presented](#) and discussed at the start of the engagement last April, and it is an opportune time to revisit these with stakeholders as we near the completion of the benefits case phase - additional background information on goals and objectives from the February SAC is attached for your reference. Feedback and proposed changes from this discussion will be used to frame the conversation for the broader engagement in the afternoon.

We ask that Working Group members come prepared for an interactive, collaborative working session that morning. Furthermore, in order to make this discussion as effective and productive as possible, we are asking all MRWG members to please submit their thoughts and feedback by **February 20** as well as proposed changes to the goal/objectives and principles for the market renewal project. We ask that everyone copies all Working Group members on their submission(s) and come prepared to present their thoughts and opinions to the group for discussion. Last, but not least, while it was important to have additional stakeholders at our last session, we request that this session is only attended by Working Group members and the designated observers.
