Peter D. Fuller is Vice President, Market & Regulatory Affairs for NRG Energy Inc. In this position, he leads policy development for NRG's state, regional and federal regulatory and policy activities primarily in the New England, New York and PJM market areas, including the company's interactions with the RTOs as well as supporting the company's asset optimization and business development efforts in the region. Mr. Fuller's work encompasses wholesale market design, climate change and related environmental policies, renewable and distributed energy policy, and the intersection of public policy objectives with competitive markets.

Mr. Fuller has served as the Vice Chair of the Independent Power Producers of New York and as state Chair of the Solar Energy Industries Association for New York, and previously served as Chairman of the New England Power Generators Association, from 2005 to 2010. Prior to joining Mirant in 2000, Mr. Fuller held a number of positions in power supply, planning and engineering with Eastern Utilities Associates.
