**Subject:** Adequacy Report - Clarification of Peak Demand Hours

Good Afternoon,

The following information is clarification on instances when the Peak Demand forecast is less than the Average Demand forecast.

Tomorrow, on February 23<sup>rd</sup>, several updates to the Adequacy Report will be implemented, including the addition of a new Forecast Ontario Demand row. This is in addition to the Peak and Average demand forecasts currently being published in the report. The new Forecast Ontario Demand row will contain either the Peak or Average demand forecast, and contains the values used for pre-dispatch scheduling.

The IESO is also in the process of making improvements to the demand forecast produced by the forecasting tool, and expects to implement these changes in the coming months. Please note that during this time there may be instances where the average demand forecast published in the Adequacy Report exceeds the peak demand forecast. If this occurs, market participants should be aware that the definitive forecast used for pre-dispatch scheduling is the value that is provided in the Forecast Ontario Demand row. The IESO expects that the frequency with which this occurs will be reduced as the improvements to the demand forecast are implemented.

The revised reports will begin publishing at 10:45 EST on February 23<sup>rd</sup>, and will be located in the existing *Adequacy2* report folder on the IESO website: <http://reports.ieso.ca/public/Adequacy2/>
