Good afternoon Jason,

I have two questions:

1. Reviewing the feedback the IESO provided to Sygration, the IESO has agreed to include a flag that would indicate whether the Ontario Forecast Demand value is Peak/Average/Administratively set. While the IESO also included a snippet of the XML that would do that, will this flag appear as an additional row in the visual report? I did not notice this flag in the report on posted on the website.  
**The flag will indicate whether it is a ramp or non-ramp hour, and will only be part of the schema, not as an additional row in the visual report.**
2. The IESO's presentation indicated the adequacy reporting changes would be in production at the end of January. On the other hand, the location where the schema was posted indicates the target production implementation is January 18<sup>th</sup>. Please confirm if January 18<sup>th</sup> is the latest implementation date.  
**The target implementation date is now mid-February, to give market participants sufficient time to review the changes to the Market Manuals, and to ensure that our operators are properly trained before go-live.**
