Re: MR-00420-R02: Capacity Exports and Transmission Outages

Attached for Technical Panel review and consideration is market rule amendment proposal MR-00420-R02: Capacity Exports and Transmitter Outages.

At its meeting on May 22nd, the Technical Panel reviewed drafts of the amendment proposals for MR-00420-R00: Capacity Exports in the IESO-Administered Markets and MR-00420-R01: Capacity Exports and Settlements, which were presented for information and discussion purposes only.

Amendment proposal (R02) is the third and last amendment to create a framework to enable Ontario-based resources to export capacity, as approved by the IESO. This amendment proposal will enable the IESO to reject or revoke a planned outage to transmission connection facilities that would cause a generation resource which is committed externally through an approved capacity export incapable of delivering electricity to the IESO-controlled grid, if the external system operator has determined that the planned outage would result in an unacceptable risk of an adequacy shortfall within its jurisdiction, and the outage is unable to be rescheduled.

The IESO has been working with stakeholders regarding concerns around the implementation details regarding transmission outages, and is publishing the amendment proposal earlier than the regularly scheduled June 19th publication date in order to provide all stakeholders with additional time to review the amendment proposal.

The remainder of the capacity export amendment proposals (R00, R01 and presentation) will be posted on the regularly scheduled June 19th publication date.

Recommendation – Priority

The IESO recommends that the Technical Panel assign a regular priority to the development of the suggested changes.

Panel Action and Next Steps

The IESO recommends that the Technical Panel agree to post MR-00420-R00-R02 for stakeholder comment for a period of two weeks, ending on July 12, 2018. The target for IESO Board consideration of the amendments is August 29, 2018.
