On behalf of Just Energy, I offer the following comments on the Draft Framework for Third Party Access.

Just Energy is a publicly traded (NYSE:JE and TSX:JE) leading North American energy management solutions provider, Just Energy specializes in electricity, natural gas, solar and green energy for almost two million customers across North America and the UK. As such, Just Energy looks to provide value to consumers across the Province through innovative product offerings.

Just Energy is excited to see the development of a Framework on Third Party Access. Just Energy supports scenario 4 access criteria but submits that the request for personal electricity consumption data, alone or matched with other data sets to authorized third parties (personal information), should be made available to all authorized third parties not just the subset of recommended requestors. If a retailer has received a consumer's consent to receive their personal electricity consumption data, alone or matched with other data, there is no basis on which the request should be withheld. The data would support product offerings tailored to the consumer needs and usage and provide value to consumers.

The draft document states that the "IESO is not recommending broad access to personal information at this time". Further, the "IESO's recommendation is that access to personal information be limited to federal, provincial and municipal governments for uses related to energy planning, policy development and other such uses, as authorized by applicable legislation, licences, directives or notifications. Such access would also be coordinated with the LDCs whose customer's personal data is being accessed.

Just Energy submits that the recommendation as to whom should be provided access should be revisited and amended to include retailers.

Just Energy would be pleased to answer any further questions and looks forward to participating in the Foundation Working Group that will further define the participants, governance framework, accountability, controls and cost recovery mechanism.
