*Thank you for sharing the De-Identification Framework Proposal. It appears well thought out and comprehensive.*

*MPAC data proposed for use in conjunction with the MDMR data does not contain personal information. As such, MPAC can provide property level data like structure size/year built/heating and cooling details... along with Lat/Long coordinates or locational addresses for identification purposes, to be coupled with MDMR data by the data custodian. Alternatively, MPAC can conduct the property matching process by acquiring non-personal information (for example Locational Address or Geo-Code) from the data custodian and return MPAC non-personal data to be integrated with the MDMR dataset.*
