Subject: Implementation of Phase 2 of Reports Site Refresh Project into Production targeted for end of July

The IESO is expecting to implement phase 2 of the reports site refresh project into production at the end of July. The exact date will be confirmed around mid July.

Phase 2 of this project affects the confidential reports only and will have the following new access methods:

- New web user interface for browser-based access
- Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) for machine access
- RESTful API for machine access
 - Query available reports using a URL request
 - API returns output as XML or JSON
 - No dependency on UI – reliable and direct access to reports

Documentation that describes the API and SFTP for automating the retrieval of confidential reports has been posted on our website at: [http://www.ieso.ca/Documents/consult/rsr/RSR-20150413-IESO Reports API Guide.pdf](http://www.ieso.ca/Documents/consult/rsr/RSR-20150413-IESO_Reports_API_Guide.pdf).

As previously communicated, the two sites will run in parallel for about six months. The IESO recommends that you set up machine access to the new site as soon as possible after release of phase 2 into production.

The new URL will be <https://reports2.ieso.ca/>. At the end of the transition period, the old report site will be decommissioned, and the new report site will be renamed to <https://reports.ieso.ca/>.

Implementation into sandbox occurred in April and the URL is <https://reports-sandbox2.ieso.ca/private>.
