On February 1, the IESO will launch the new private IESO Reports site and decommission the current site.

### **What does this mean?**

As of February 1, you will access the new Reports Site via <https://reports.ieso.ca/private/>. The IESO will communicate with you on February 1 when the new reports site is in service.

The new reports site is currently accessed via <https://reports2.ieso.ca/private/>. Both URLs will run in parallel until February 8, at which time we will remove <https://reports2.ieso.ca/private/>. This is to allow sufficient time to update machine access with the new URL.

The current reports site, accessed via <https://reports.ieso.ca/private/> will be decommissioned on February 1 and this URL will be assigned to the new reports site as mentioned above.

The new reports site offers the following access methods:

- New web user interface for browser-based access
- Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) for machine access
- RESTful API for machine access
  - Query available reports using a URL request
  - API returns output as XML or JSON
  - No dependency on UI – reliable and direct access to reports

The attached document describes the API and SFTP for automating retrieval of private reports and is to be used as of February 1. Until then, please refer to the current guide posted on our website at <http://www.ieso.ca/Pages/Participate/Technical-Interfaces.aspx#>.
