The Outage Management Process Redesign meeting scheduled for Wednesday November 26 has been cancelled.

This will allow for further development and analysis in each of the following areas:

- Security & Adequacy Reporting Proposal for the Redesigned Weekly and Daily Advance Approval Processes
  - As mentioned at the October 15 meeting, recommendations for reporting improvements have been forwarded to a new initiative that will focus on redesigning the existing SSR and SAA reports. This refresh initiative is still in the process of completing a draft proposal for stakeholders to review and provide feedback on. Outage Management Process Redesign participants will be notified when the draft proposal is made public.
- Security & Adequacy Reporting Proposal for Redesigned Quarterly Advance Approval Process
  - Further analysis is required to address potential process inefficiencies in producing a completely new security and adequacy report compared to leveraging existing 18 Month Outlook reports to support outage planning under the redesigned Quarterly Advance Approval process.

Our next meeting will be scheduled in the first quarter of 2015 to discuss the outcomes of these reviews along with a preferred approach for the redesigned outage management process.

Also, please find attached the final version of the Outage Management Redesign Requirements Summary document. In addition to accepting the red-lined changes made to the last version, a minor clarification was made to the definition of the Outage Request 'Study' status in the Glossary of Terms.
