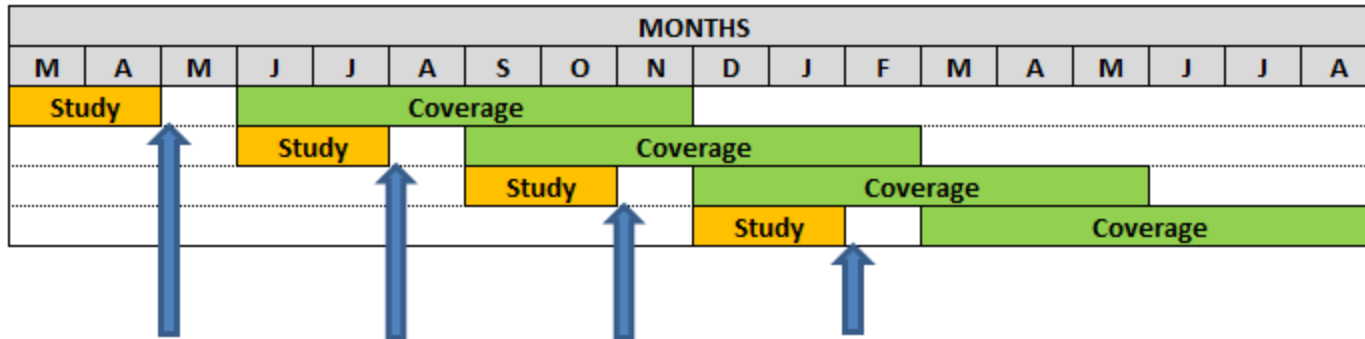

Requirements Summary Document: Clarification and Changes

- Clarification
 - Appendix G updated to show Lines and Line Sections have the same constraint code applicability
- Software Change
 - “Conflict Rationale” will be a mandatory field when submitting an outage request in conflict
 - Benefits:
 - Increased awareness
 - Coordination and communication efficiency

Proposed IESO Reporting Obligations: Quarterly Advance Approval Process

- New obligation to provide at least 6 months of updated security and adequacy information on a quarterly basis



Security and Adequacy Information Reported by 17:00 EST on the business day after the Study Period

- Reporting mechanisms still under consideration

Proposed IESO Reporting Obligations: Weekly and Daily Advance Approval Process

- Leverage existing reporting obligations (i.e. Daily and Weekly SAA reports)
- Adequacy Reporting engagement (SE-AR) outcomes
 - Stakeholder feedback received and currently being considered

Market Rules:

Schedule and Stakeholder Expectations

- ***April 2015 Technical Panel (TP)***
 - Vote that the amendment submission warrants consideration
- ***Spring 2015 to Fall 2015***
 - Introduce proposed amendment to the TP
 - Vote to post proposed amendment for stakeholder comment
 - Vote to recommend proposed amendment to IESO Board
 - SE-109 updated throughout the TP process
- ***Fall 2015***
 - IESO Board Vote to approve proposed market rule amendment
