**Subject:** Settlement Meter Data Applications Working Group (SE-113) feedback

Enersource areas of consideration are:

1. Can the totalized DP data be available next day as current process?
  - a. If the totalized DP not available till day later, this delay could impact timeliness of Form1598 submission. Will the window for 1598 submission be extended by an extra day? The delay of DP data reduces the amount of time LDC has to react to situations such as use of historical data, MSP data re-submission, etc.
2. Currently Enersource uses following files types from the IESO:
  - EDI files
  - Preliminary and Final Statement files
  - Invoice files (XML)
  - HOEP hourly data
  - Demand hourly data

IESO confirmed during the call that there is no intention of changing or eliminating any of the existing file format. If this decision changes, we will need additional time to make necessary system integration changes on our side.

Enersource would like to be part of any parallel testing that will take place in 2014.
