Good afternoon,

Rodan appreciates the opportunity to continue its role in support of the IESO's demand-side initiatives through the Demand Response Working Group. As with our membership in the previous incarnation of this group, we value the opportunity to articulate the perspective of the province's largest aggregator with the most diverse portfolio of DSM resources.

With respect to the DR Working Group Terms of Reference, Rodan suggests that in the absence of any other regular review process for CBDR, this working group should allow for discussion of, and facilitate adjustments to the CBDR program. Although the CBDR portfolio is slowly decreasing as contracts expire (and some move to the auction), some contract schedules will remain in place and still be operational through 2018. Since CBDR is a closed program and not necessarily of interest to the entire group, a CBDR subcommittee might be more appropriate to address operational issues.

Rodan is pleased to be an ongoing part of the evolution of demand response in Ontario with the IESO and our industry colleagues, and we look forward to helping refine these initiatives to deliver the maximum benefit and flexibility to the system.
