General Comments/Feedback

In slide 8 of the engagement presentation, the IESO indicated expanding the Day-Ahead Market (DAM) Make-Whole Payment (MWP) design change for storage to other energy limited resources. OPG has two clarification questions:

1. Can the IESO provide an exhaustive list of resource types that are considered “energy limited resources” and thus would be subject to the proposed DAM MWP design changes?
2. There was no expansion language in the Real-Time Market (RTM) MWP design change section of the presentation. Can the IESO confirm that the RTM MWP design changes will not be expanded to other energy limited resources, as in the case of the DAM MWP?

OPG thanks the IESO for the opportunity to provide feedback on the Enabling Resources Program – Storage and Co-Located Hybrid Integration Project engagement and looks forward to working closely with the IESO on this and future engagements.
