Please provide feedback or concerns with the design concepts included in the Settlements design memo.	Please consider updates to the operating profit function, inaccessible OR and internal congestion and loss residuals to impact only SMSR resources on the charge codes and/or equations to avoid any unintentional impact on other resources.
	The new RT MWP adjustment charge when determining ineligibility is being looked at over a calculation period which could be up to end of trade date. Please confirm if the IESO will clarify what the period is in the market files or settlement statements.
	EOPs are key criteria in preliminary settlement data files. With the additional SoC model for EOP calculations now required in the EOP engine, it is important as part of this process that the EOPs can still be published in time for the preliminary settlement data file. Please confirm that EOPs will be published in time for the preliminary settlement data file.
