Do you have any feedback to share on the proposed mandatory requirements for the LT2(e) RFP, including Municipal and Indigenous Support Resolutions requirements as well as requirements for siting projects on Crown Land?	<p>The role of Municipal and Indigenous support resolutions requires greater clarity.</p> <p>I have listened to the portion of the recording addressing this issue, starting around 2:18 hours, several times, and I still find the replies to be somewhat confusing. The IESO stated that the municipal support resolution is only an indication that the municipality is in favour of having the proponent's proposal brought forward for evaluation. What happens after that is between the proponent and the municipality. The proponent and municipality will still have to work together on permitting, site plans, etc.</p> <p>This could be interpreted to mean that once a municipality provides a support resolution, it is committed to ongoing discussions with a proponent until the project can be approved. It does not answer the question that if a municipality provides a support resolution, than decides at a later date that a project is not in its best interest, can that municipality withdraw its support resolution and bring all discussion on that project to a complete and final stop and have that project removed from the IESO's consideration?</p> <p>This requires a more direct response from the IESO.</p>
