General Comments/Feedback

1. Given the introduction of the windowed approach, conformation is required from MNR that Applicant of Record Status will be maintained across the windows equivalent to the procurement of MW originally proposed by the IESO for LT2
2. The OWA requires confirmation that incremental waterpower energy and capacity from existing facilities will be eligible to participate in the windowed approach, consistent with the Minister's Direction on the Northern Hydro Program with respect to LT2.
