Training Formats

Online interactive training modules

- Two Types:
 - Change topic focused overviews with goal of introducing key topics (for example: locational marginal price, market power mitigation, and pseudo-unit modelling)
 - Market Overviews: Market segment focused walkthroughs of market renewal impact from registration to settlement (Note: Live Q&A sessions will be available)

2. Guides, Quick Takes, and Instructions

- Documents focused on providing in-depth information related to all change topics
- Purpose is to supplement the reader's understanding of the changes to the Market Rules and Manuals

Training Formats

3. Live Training Sessions

- Live, interactive sessions focused on providing demos of system changes and other focused topics as appropriate
- Purpose is to help market participants complete necessary tasks before go-live

- Segments to be covered: Non-Quick Start, Pseudo Unit, Hydro, Storage, Intertie,
 Non-Dispatchable Load, Price Responsive Load, Dispatchable Load, and Virtual
- Live Q&A sessions will be offered a week or more after each overview is posted to allow participants to ask questions about the content and scenarios once they have an opportunity to complete the training module on their own time
