Re: Market Renewal Program (MRP): Update on Market Participant Reports

Two additional reports that will require revisions have been identified. It is expected that these reports' schema, sample, and help files will be posted and available on the [Technical Reference Materials](#) section of the Market Renewal webpage during Q1 2025. The updated list of market facing reports will be posted under the [Technical Reference Materials](#) section of the Market Renewal webpage at the end of June 2024.

The additional reports to be revised are:

1. Weekly Market Summary Report

The Weekly Market Summary Report is a public report issued daily with information on Ontario demand and price (HOEP) for the previous seven days. The IESO initially communicated that the Weekly Market Summary Report was going to be discontinued as the information in it would be available through the [ieso.ca](#) data pages.

Based on reporting frequency and a need for historical reports to be accessible to market participants, IESO has decided to continue providing this report and will revise it. While no changes are required for demand-related information, the report does need to be revised to replace HOEP with Day-Ahead Ontario Zonal Price under MRP.

At this time, the IESO does not expect a sample of the revised report to be available for market trials.

2. Hourly Uplift and Intertie Offer Guarantee Estimates Report

This report provides Market Participants with an estimate in real-time of the hourly uplift and intertie offer guarantee rates that may appear on their settlement statements.

The IESO had planned to retire the Hourly Uplift and Intertie Offer Guarantee Estimates Report and has now agreed to continue to provide it based on feedback from Market Participants.

The report will be revised to align with the new data and settlements equations which the MRP is introducing.

At this time, the IESO does not expect a sample of the revised report to be available for the market trials.
