Theme: Tie Line Outage Rate

- Tie line outages are currently assumed to be zero, but how may this change in the future?
- Does Ontario determine the line ratings?
- Will the ratings/losses of the lines feeding into the borders be considered?

General Discussion

- Non-recallability of imports is a feature of the current Northeast MOU.
- UCAP is based on transmission capability, rather than a specific resource or fleet capability.
- Inquiry as to whether UCAP will be seasonal. IESO responded that UCAP will be seasonal.
- For resource-backed imports, the IESO will require agreements with other jurisdictions.
