## Revised Forward Capacity Auction Proposal

<p>Please provide any feedback on the revised Forward Capacity Auction (FCA) proposal. <i>(slides 15/16 of the July 21 presentation)</i></p>	<p>With the previous Forward Capacity Auction proposal, a participant could be awarded a 3 year term which would likely be of high value to most participants.</p> <p>With the revised Forward Capacity Auction, the risk now exists that a participant may not be awarded all of the FCA #1, #2, or #3 and may only be awarded one or two. For this reason, this new proposal could possibly decrease the number of potential participants in the Forward Capacity Auction.</p>

## Timing of Annual Capacity Auction (ACA)

<p>Please provide any feedback on the proposed timing of the Annual Capacity Auction (ACA).</p> <p>Is there support for shifting the ACA earlier in the year? Are there any concerns? <i>(slide 17 of the July 21 presentation)</i></p>	<p>The longer forward period of the Annual Capacity Auction may be beneficial to certain parties while maintaining the alignment of summer and winter obligation periods.</p> <p>This allows better alignment of the auction with the release of the Annual Planning Outlook. This would allow participants to make a greater informed decision when participating in the Auction.</p>
