DER Market Vision and Design Project - T-D Coordination Foundational Questions	In developing foundational models, Toronto Hydro encourages the IESO to reconsider factors that risk inhibiting DER(A) participation in wholesale markets. At present, the proposal excludes local distribution companies ("LDCs") as market participants on the basis of "regulatory clarity". Toronto Hydro cautions the IESO from presuming LDC participation is currently prohibited, and notes its GIF Dual Participation project was approved by the Ontario Energy Board, in part, because it helps manage the capacity of the grid. Foundational coordination protocols should reflect the possibility that LDCs can and do act as market participants. To the extent that the proposed participation by distributors requires consideration and interpretation by the OEB, Toronto Hydro requests that exercise take place prior the Market Design phase. Any such conclusion by the IESO without this interpretation would be premature and may inhibit DER(A) participation in wholesale markets.

Conceptual T-D Coordination Protocol for Dual Participation Model Does the draft conceptual T-D protocol for the Dual Participation model presented provide the opportunity for sufficient coordination among parties?	Toronto Hydro notes it is not clear how the draft conceptual protocol would apply if the LDC was the market participant (i.e. DER/aggregator) and encourages the IESO to make this clarification.
Are there any gaps/concerns with the draft T-D protocol presented?	Additionally, the IESO has indicated a T-D protocol will be discussed in early 2023 for the Total DSO model. To this point, will the Dual Participation model be evaluated against the Total DSO model? If so, will this be done before the protocol is finalized?
