

This page sets out the instructions for completing the Prescribed Form: Evidence of Municipal Support (Capacity).

All capitalized or italicized terms used in these instructions and the Prescribed Form: Evidence of Municipal Support (Capacity), unless otherwise stated, have the meanings ascribed to them in the LLT(c) RFP.

INSTRUCTIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL PRESCRIBED FORMS:

- a. The first page of a Prescribed Form should be marked with the name of the LLT Capacity Project that is the subject of the Proposal. The Proponent should use the name given to the LLT Capacity Project in the Prescribed Form: Proponent Information, Declarations and Workbook (Capacity).
- b. This instruction page is not required to be submitted as part of the completed Prescribed Form.
- c. The Prescribed Form is required to be submitted electronically via email to the IESO at LLT.RFP@ieso.ca.
- d. Information provided in each Prescribed Form should be consistent with the information provided in the Proposal.
- e. If a field in the Prescribed Form is pre-populated with "As indicated in the Proposal Workbook", the Proponent is not to input any further information in such pre-populated field.
- f. Where the Prescribed Form has multiple pages, the pages of the Prescribed Form should be kept together in the Proposal in sequential order.
- g. Where a blank field for a section/page reference is provided in a Prescribed Form, enter the section/page reference of the Proposal where the substantiating evidence for that particular item can be found.
- h. Apart from the completion of any blanks, drop down lists, check boxes or similar uncompleted information in a Prescribed Form, no amendments may be made to the wording of a Prescribed Form.
- i. Each Prescribed Form must be completed in its entirety. Fields marked <if applicable> must be completed if applicable to the Proposal. If not applicable, they should be marked "Not Applicable".
- j. If a signature is required for a Prescribed Form, the Prescribed Form must be signed by a person with authority to bind the Proponent. The Prescribed Form may be printed, signed and scanned, or may be signed digitally through Adobe (Digital ID, or Fill and Sign), Apple Preview or DocuSign.

- k. With the exception of this instruction page, instructions within a Prescribed Form will be enclosed in brackets.

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INSTRUCTIONS SPECIFIC TO THIS PRESCRIBED FORM: EVIDENCE OF MUNICIPAL SUPPORT (CAPACITY):

- l. To meet the mandatory requirements of Section 4.2(a) of the LLT(c) RFP, where the Project Site is proposed to be located in whole or in part on Municipal Lands, a Proponent must complete and submit in the Proposal: i) the main body of this Prescribed Form and ii) a copy of the applicable Municipal Support Confirmation attached as Exhibit B, as indicated in Section 3, from each Local Municipality with authority over the Municipal Lands comprising the Project Site.
- m. Councils of Local Municipalities have the option of using the form of Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission provided in Exhibit A, should they so choose. An alternative to the Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission is a Blanket Municipal Support Resolution provided together with a Blanket MS Confirmation Letter.
- n. Where the Municipal Support Confirmation is in the form of a Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission, such resolution must be dated no earlier than February 27, 2026.
- o. Where the Municipal Support Confirmation is in the form of a Blanket Municipal Support Resolution together with a Blanket MS Confirmation Letter, such Blanket MS Confirmation Letter must be dated no earlier than February 27, 2026.
- p. A Municipal Support Confirmation is not required if the Project Site of the LLT Capacity Project is located wholly on Indigenous Lands, Provincial Crown Lands or Federal Crown Lands and located outside of Municipal Lands, Unincorporated Territory, or any combination thereof.

GUIDANCE FOR MUNICIPALITIES:

The IESO is undertaking the LLT(c) RFP to competitively procure year-round capacity services, on a Maximum Contract Capacity basis from Electricity Storage Facilities, each with a Nameplate Capacity equal to or larger than ten (10) MW, that: (A) is a New Build and provides dispatchable capacity services to meet system reliability needs; (B) is directly connected to a Distribution System or a Transmission System in Ontario and uses its own meter(s) to Deliver and Withdraw Electricity (for clarity, "its own meter(s)" means meter(s) not used by any other facility) in accordance with all Laws and Regulations to and from the *IESO-controlled grid*; (C) is comprised of one or more *electricity storage units* that are capable of being registered under the Market Rules other than as a *self-scheduling electricity storage facility*; (D) has a Duration Capability of at least eight (8) consecutive hours during the Qualifying Hours; (E) uses Eligible LDES Technology as its sole means of storing and delivering Electricity withdrawn from the Connection Point; (F) has Withdrawal Capability that is equal to or greater than the Contract Capacity in each of Winter and Summer; and (G) in the case of a Regulation Ready-Required Facility, meets the Regulation Services Readiness Requirements.

Should a Local Municipality wish to support the submission of a Proposal for a particular LLT Capacity Project, a group of LLT Capacity Projects, or one or more particular Eligible LDES Technology types, they must either pass a Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission (project-specific) or a Blanket Municipal Support Resolution. Where a Blanket

Municipal Support Resolution is passed, a Blanket MS Confirmation Letter (project-specific), containing the same project-specific information and statements as set out in the template Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission, must be provided together with the Blanket Municipal Support Resolution.

Local Municipalities are encouraged to use the template Municipal Resolution in Support of Proposal Submission in Exhibit A. Should a Local Municipality wish to develop its own resolution, the resolution must:

- (A) identify:
 - (i) the Unique Project ID of the LLT Capacity Project (if available);
 - (ii) the name of the LLT Capacity Project;
 - (iii) the name of the Proponent;
 - (iv) the Eligible LDES Technology of the LLT Capacity Project;
 - (v) the maximum potential Contract Capacity of the LLT Capacity Project (which must not be less than, and may exceed, the Maximum Contract Capacity ultimately provided in the Prescribed Form: Proponent Information, Declarations and Workbook (Capacity) in respect of the LLT Capacity Project); and
 - (vi) the Property Identification Number (PIN), municipal address, legal description or GPS coordinates of the Municipal Lands that comprise the Project Site;
- (B) confirm that the Proponent has, no later than sixty (60) days prior to the date of the Municipal Support Confirmation, delivered a Pre-Engagement Confirmation Notice to an applicable Local Body Administrator in respect of the Local Municipality, that includes the information above (a sample of a Pre-Engagement Confirmation Notice has been provided in Exhibit C for your convenience);
- (C) state:
 - (i) that the Local Municipality supports the submission of a Proposal for the LLT Capacity Project located on the applicable Municipal Lands. The statement in such resolution may be qualified as being solely for the purposes of satisfying the mandatory requirements under Section 4.2(a) of the LLT(c) RFP, and does not supersede any applicable permits or approvals under applicable Laws and Regulations that may be required for a particular LLT Capacity Project;
 - (ii) that the Proponent has undertaken, or has committed to undertake, Indigenous and community engagement activities in respect of the LLT Capacity Project to the satisfaction of the Local Municipality;
 - (iii) whether or not any Municipal Lands comprising the Project Site are designated as Prime Agricultural Areas or Specialty Crop Areas as set out in the Local Municipality's Official Plan as of the date of the resolution; and
 - (iv) if any Municipal Lands comprising the Project Site are designated as Prime Agricultural Areas:

- (a) the Proponent has satisfied the AIA Component One Requirement to the satisfaction of the Local Municipality; and
 - (b) if the Proponent is selected as a Selected Proponent under the LLT(c) RFP, the Local Municipality will engage in good faith with the Selected Proponent to enable the Selected Proponent to complete the AIA Components Two and Three Requirement; and
- (D) be dated and include signatures of applicable council members adopting the resolution.

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Capitalized terms not defined herein have the meanings ascribed to them in the LLT(c) RFP.
