

**Market Renewal Program (MRP) – Feedback received on the Draft Term Sheets for Non-Utility Generator (NUG) Contracts**

The IESO requested feedback from Contract counterparties on the draft term sheets for NUG contracts (the “Contracts”) dated February 1, 2024 with feedback to be submitted by March 15, 2024. The draft term sheet updates were made based on the feedback received from Suppliers on previous versions and the market rule amendments that have been provisionally approved by the IESO Board of Directors.
