What perspectives do you have on the high-level wire and non-wire options?	Recent information needs to be considered regarding Norfolk County urban boundary expansions which includes the need for substantial hydro increases. It is estimated that the Industrial Park could require 30-40 MW, and the residential could be around 2 MW.

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<p>What additional information should be considered in the assessment of these options?</p>	<p>Courtland is expanding its urban area substantially for a future industrial parking including manufacturing.</p>
<p>Are there any additional information that should be provided in future engagements to help understand municipal perspectives and insights?</p>	<p>We believe it is vital to meet in person to discuss the increase in need for hydro services to support the potential for future industrial and residential development in Courtland. There is not enough available hydro to allow existing industry to expand now. Much more is forthcoming.</p>
