Hi IESO Engagement,

According to page 27 of the IESO's "Ontario-Quebec Interconnection Capability: A Technical Review" (2017), Ontario could increase its ability to import Quebec waterpower by 2,000 MW by building a new inter-tie at Chats' Falls and by upgrading the Gatineau Corridor between Chats' Falls and the GTA.

Your April 14, 2022 PPT presentation about the Gatineau Corridor includes recommendations to re-build the Gatineau transmission corridor. If these recommendations are implemented, what additional actions would be needed to increase Ontario's ability to import an additional 2,000 MW from Quebec via Chats' Falls and the Gatineau Corridor? What would be the approximate capital costs of these additional measures?
