The Gatineau transmission corridor is 300 kilometres long and stretches between the Greater Toronto Area East and Ottawa and passes through Peterborough. The planning study underway examines transmission equipment reaching end-of-life (EOL) in the Gatineau corridor, assesses the scope of refurbishment for that equipment and looks at broader reliability needs in the area.
