The IESO invites all interested parties to participate in regional electricity planning now underway in Southern Huron-Perth, a sub-region of [Greater Bruce/Huron](#). A long-term electricity plan – Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) – will be developed to assess Southern Huron-Perth’s electricity system and recommend a set of actions to maintain a reliable supply of electricity over the next 20 years.
