## General Comments/Feedback

Enbridge Gas is interested in how policy changes since the demand forecast was developed (such as Ontario's Bill 17 and the implementation of Canada's Clean Electricity Regulations), have been or will be incorporated into the IESO's planning.

As the IRRP and LAPs are developed, Enbridge Gas is interested to know if the IESO has or will be evaluating small scale (i.e. <10 MW) behind-the-meter (BTM) gas-powered generation to reduce demand on the electricity grid. These units are readily available in Ontario, and could be a solution for residential homeowners or small businesses for typical applications requiring hot water, such as multi-unit residential buildings, and small commercial and institutional sectors. This could be one solution to help defer the need for new infrastructure and overbuilding the electricity system.
