

[Regional electricity planning](#) kicked off in the London Area to ensure a reliable supply of electricity and support local growth and economic development in January 2025. Regional planning looks at the unique needs of each region and considers wire and non-wire options and innovative resources to meet the needs. The London Area electrical region encompasses the municipalities of Oxford County, Middlesex County, Elgin County, City of London, City of St. Thomas, and part of Norfolk County.

As a first step, the IESO-led regional planning process involves determining the most appropriate planning approach going forward to meet electricity needs through a scoping assessment. Now, the IESO has posted the draft [Scoping Assessment Outcome Report](#) and a [narrated video presentation](#) summarizing the key details on the London engagement webpage.
