PNE Canada agrees that a more resilient transmission and distribution network is required; however, we question that localized NWAs would only benefit particular load, as stated in the IESO's conclusions. PNE Canada recommends expanding the IESO's analysis with updated information on the potential of wind and solar power generation technologies.
