Your feedback is important to help shape the development of an Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) which includes a set of recommended actions to maintain a reliable supply of electricity for the Peterborough to Kingston region over the next 20 years. The July 28 webinar follows an [earlier webinar](#) held in March 2021 that sought input on the future electricity needs for communities and stakeholders as well as feedback on the draft engagement plan. The IESO's response to that feedback and all other materials related to this engagement initiative can be found on the engagement webpage.

The Peterborough to Kingston region is defined on electrical infrastructure boundaries, and roughly encompasses the regional municipalities of Frontenac County, Hasting County, Northumberland County, Peterborough County, Prince Edward County, and parts of Lennox & Addington County and related municipalities.

All interested parties are invited and encouraged to participate including, but not limited to, local municipalities, Indigenous communities, businesses, stakeholders and members of the general public.
