Regional electricity planning continues for the [Renfrew region](#). A webinar is scheduled for February 9, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. to provide an update on the planning status and give an overview of the electricity needs identified for the area. The IESO is seeking feedback on the electricity demand forecast, identified needs and proposed plan for engagement to help inform the development of an Integrated Regional Resource Plan (IRRP) for the region, which is expected to be posted in Q3 2022.

The Renfrew region is defined on electrical infrastructure boundaries, and roughly encompasses the towns of Arnprior, Deep River, Laurentian Hills, Petawawa and Renfrew, the townships of Admaston/Bromley, Bonnechere Valley, Brudenell, Lyndoch and Raglan, Greater Madawaska, Head, Clara and Maria Horton, Killaloe, Hagarty and Richards, Laurentian Valley, Madawaska Valley, McNab/Braeside, North Algona Wilberforce and Whitewater Region; as well as the City of Pembroke.

All interested parties are invited and encouraged to participate including, but not limited to, local municipalities, Indigenous communities, businesses, stakeholders and members of the general public.
