The South Georgian Bay/Muskoka electrical region generally encompasses the Cities of Barrie, Kawartha Lakes, and Orillia, the Districts of Muskoka and Parry Sound, the Region of Durham and the Counties of Grey, Dufferin, Haliburton and Simcoe.

On July 27 at 1-2pm, the IESO will host a 60-minute [webinar](#) to provide an overview of the regional electricity planning process, and seek feedback on the draft electricity demand forecast, and two demand scenarios.
