Agenda Item 6: MACD Update (Self Certifications/Covid 19 Update)

Nada Bojevski delivered the MACD Update on Self-Certifications

ND highlighted the good practice in 2020 CMP for NERC FAC-008-3, NERC PRC-005-6, NERC CIP-002-5.1.

Observations from SC reviews

General

- Submissions did not include a completed RSAW or an alternative compliance narrative;
- Documents provided were not dated and signed;
- In the case of parent companies' documents, it was not clear to which market participants/facilities the provided evidence applied.
- Specific detail of findings for each standard are posted in the meeting materials.

Nada Bojevski also delivered the 2021 CMP OVERVIEW

2021 CMP is to be posted by the end of December 2020.

It will be posted on the IESO System Reliability Internet page.

The CMP Lists the reliability standards (NERC reliability standards, NPCC criteria and Ontario market rules) to be the focus of MACD's compliance monitoring activities in 2021.

- It will provide insights into the discovery methods that MACD may use to assess compliance with these obligations.

2021 CMP Considerations:

MACD considered several factors, including the applicability of reliability standards in Ontario, the reliability risks of the standards at continent-wide and regional levels as reflected in the NERC CMEP and NPCC IP, the compliance history associated with each standard; and emerging threats and vulnerabilities impacting the power system.

What to Expect in 2021

- MACD will issue self-certifications as early as Q1 2021;
- Selected market participants will receive notification, via the Reliability Compliance Tool or the IESO/MACD Compliance Monitoring collaboration community;
- NERC RSAW (or a link to) will accompany the self-certification request for a specific reliability standard; market participant is expected to submit the completed RSAW (preferably in the MSWord format), or a narrative on how it meets compliance (refer to the "Compliance Assessment" section of the RSAW for guidance).
- Market participant is expected to attach evidence of compliance (e.g. documented policies, procedures and plans, maintenance reports, etc.);
- PRC-005-6 maintenance worksheet template is expected to be filled out and submitted as selfcertification evidence.

MM11.5 draft was circulated for comment in Nov, some feedback provided- held open discussion, No significant items brought forward.

Feedback from comments form indicated the changes are supported, but some minor clarifications are required.

IESO aiming to put final version through Baseline 45- and will communicate revisions to RSSC members.

The final version should not represent a significant change from draft that was shared (minor changes for clarity or editorial.
