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Clarifications to the Market Rules (Omnibus 2021)

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Market Rules Omnibus process

- The omnibus process is conducted annually to clean up issues identified in the market rules, such as
 - Inconsistent formatting
 - Grammatical errors
 - Typos
- Typically, the omnibus has allowed for inclusion of changes that do not require a separate engagement initiative

2021 Omnibus

The 2021 omnibus contains proposals for both minor and other amendments

- Two 'non-minor' proposals are included that are not expected to change market participant obligations
- Inclusion in this omnibus will reduce the number of amendment submissions for TP members to review
- For clarity, each proposal is delineated in a separate package

Minor Amendment

minor amendment, in respect of the *market rules*, means an *amendment* to the *market rules* to correct a typographical or grammatical error, or to effect a change of a non-material procedural nature
